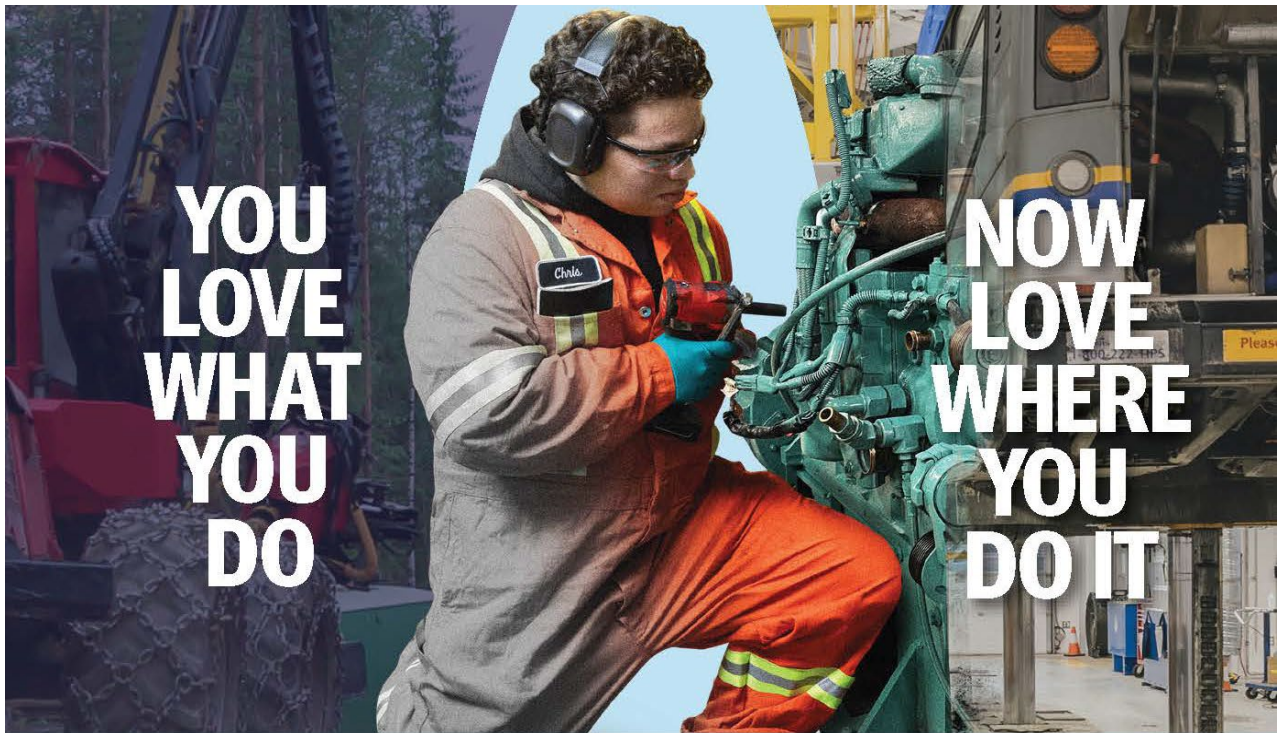

MARCH MEETING FOLLOW-UP

BEYOND THE POLICY **WHAT EVERY DRIVER AND BUSINESS OWNER SHOULD ASK AND KNOW ABOUT VEHICLE COVERAGE AND REGISTRATION**

INSURANCE RATING MODEL OVERVIEW

ICBC has moved to a more driver-based model focusing on Driver experience and crash history. Doing so this will play a bigger role in premium calculation and driver Accountability. The scan period for regular vehicles is 20 years.

For those within the Fleetplan program rating is based off of Vehicles experience and not driver's experience. The calculation is based on 3 year rolling scan period. Fleets also have the ability to repay claims to aid in discount improvement.



COVERAGE TO BE AWARE OF

1.) Basic Third Party Liability:

- Accident Benefits
- Uninsured Motorist Protection
- Inverse Liability Coverage

2.) Extended Third Party Liability: Protects against

lawsuits and major claims. Often required by municipalities and corporate clients. Recommended limits are between \$2 M & \$10 M depending on the insureds exposure.

3.) Collision & Comprehensive: Collision covers impact with vehicles or objects.

Comprehensive covers Fire, Theft, Vandalism, Glass, Malicious Mischief, Impact with animals and falling objects. Choosing a deductible for these should be based on your cash flow and comfortability level.

4.) Loss of Use Covers rental or replacement vehicle costs

5.) Tools, Cargo & Equipment Commercial Auto policies do not automatically cover these items. A separate non auto policy will need to be issued.

6.) Non-Owned Auto Liability and Physical Damage Protects your business when employees use their own vehicles for work purposes.

7.) Garage Policy extended coverage for auto-related businesses. This provides coverage when the business is found negligent when in the care custody and control of vehicles of others.

If the operation is involved in crossing borders either out of province or out of country, Liability limits need to be confirmed for conformity, in order for proper insurance certificate satisfaction.

A strong BC Commercial Auto policy should: 1.) Meet the ICBC Requirements, 2.) Add the right optional coverages, 3.) Reflect real-world vehicle use, 4.) Protect against downtime and liability, 4.) Scale with your operations

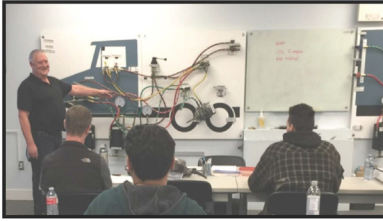

Air Brake Instructor Certification

A Provincial Government Approved Course

This ICBC approved program is designed to give participants the knowledge to effectively prepare and deliver an air brake course.

The course concentrates on instructional methods and technical content for air brake systems.

Course content includes topics of instructional procedures such as lesson plans, coaching, effective teaching techniques questioning techniques and developing multiple choice questions.

Technical content includes topics on the basic air brake system, dual air brake system, trailer air brake systems, brake adjustment and air brake valves.

Each student is given an opportunity for "hands on" experience in assembling and instruction using a fully operational air brake board. The air brake board has fully interchangeable components and is capable of simulating all types of air brake systems.

Each student is required to develop and present two 45 minute presentations to the class. Topics will be on air brake systems and the instructor will allocate the topics on the first day of class.

Each student must obtain 80% on each presentation to pass the course. An informational entrance exam is given on the first day and a final theory exam is given at the end of the

week. Each participant must obtain 80% on the final theory exam to be successful.

Each student is given a "Driving Commercial Vehicles" handbook, a course manual which includes technical information and Provincial And Federal air brake regulations.

IMPORTANT ACTION REQUIRED BY STUDENT:

To confirm the two years of air brake experience, the applicant will need to obtain a customized Driver's Abstract with a note added to their driving record which displays the date they received their (endorsement 15) air brake endorsement.

The applicant must phone ICBC to get this customized driving record emailed or mailed to them.

Regular online driving records or those produced at a Driver Licensing Office will not have this information.

Once copy is obtained, you may proceed to register.

In accordance with ICBC

- Certification does not guarantee that ICBC will issue a Driver Training Instructor's licence, an Air Brake Instructor Certificate of Qualification, or a designation on a Driver Training Instructor's licence;
- ICBC may require a Certified Trainee to be re-examined by ICBC;
- ICBC will have access to the Trainee's Training and Assessment records

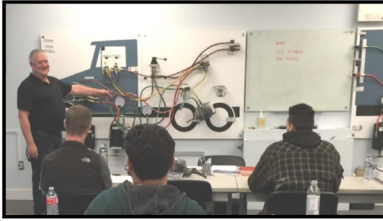

Authorized Inspector Certificate Course

Provincial Government recognized Certification Course upon successful completion

This course is required for journey person mechanics wanting to become certified as an Authorized Commercial Motor Vehicle Inspector.

This 3-day course will include two days of theory and one day of practical.

Prerequisites include Certificate of Qualification (TQ#) or Red Seal status in Commercial Transport Mechanical Repair, Commercial Transport Trailer Repair, Heavy Duty Mechanical Repair or Automotive Repair Trades.

Participants are eligible to receive their Authorized Inspector Certification upon successful completion of the course.

This course will cover the following content:

- Classes of motor vehicles,
- Motor Vehicle Act and Regulations,
- Designated Inspection Facility Program,
- Preventative Maintenance Program,
- Inspector Qualifications and Responsibilities,
- Responsibilities of Facility Operators and Inspectors,
- Commercial Vehicle Inspection manual,
- Procedures for forms completion and decal application,
- Vehicle Inspection e-forms general procedures and how to sign up,
- Preparation and administration of Authorized Inspectors examination,

NOTE student requirements:

A mobile BC Services Card registered for use to access online government application <https://www2.gov.bc.ca/gov/content/governments/government-id/bc-services-card/log-inwith-card>

Students are required to bring to class a laptop computer, tablet or mobile device to take the examination and apply for their inspector certificate.

CSA approved safety glasses and footwear is required during the practical portion of the course. Footwear must be steel-toed leather, ankle covering boots.

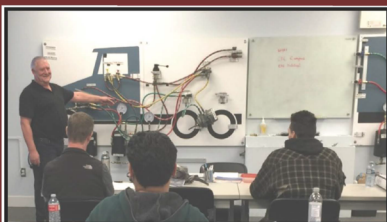

This 1 day, 8-hour course prepares Designated/Preventative Maintenance Program Inspection Facility owner (s)/operator (s) for the Facility Operator's Course examination.

The Facility Operator Course training course educates the course participant of the program objectives, authorized inspector obligations, and a clear recognition of operator responsibilities and liabilities.

The Facility Operator Course provides a consistent platform of instruction to ensure business operations are complying with all applicable regulations, legislation, program requirements, and standards.

Students are required to bring a 2016 Vehicle Inspection Manual (hard copy) or Vehicle Safety & Inspection Standards online and computer or tablet is recommended

Commercial Vehicle Cargo Securement

This 1/2-day (4 hour) program is designed for Fleet and Safety Managers, as well as all commercial vehicle operators, as per the new *Load Securement Standard* under schedule 10 of the National Safety Code. This course will equip managers and operators with the necessary skills to secure loads according to current regulatory requirements and industry "best practices".

ALL cargo being transported on the highway system must remain on or within the transporting vehicle under all conditions which could reasonably be expected to occur in normal driving, and when a driver is responding to emergency situations, short of a crash.

Drivers: Know how to properly secure the load.

Managers: Know that your fleet is in compliance and drivers & equipment are legal

Note: New North American Load Securement Standards in effect January 1, 2005.

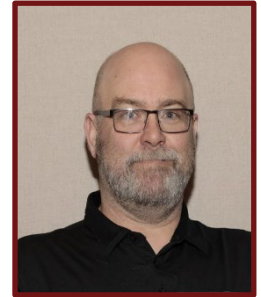

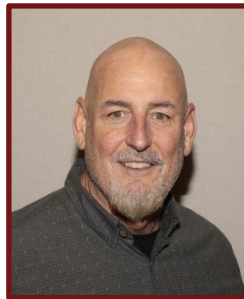

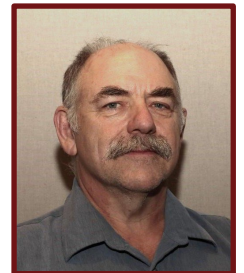
